## COMMITTEE REPORT

## COMMITTEE ON FINANCE, BUDGET, APPROPRIATIONS, AND WAYS AND MEANS


Our committee conducted a committee meeting on September 7, 2022 and discussed the referred agendas assigned to the committee of the undersigned, the following items in the Order of Business, to wit:

- 1. Agenda No. 337 Supplemental Budget No. 03 series of 2022 of the Municipality of Hermosa, Bataan, involving a total appropriation of ₱81,298,000.00 under Appropriation Ordinance No. 14, series of 2022.
- 2. Agenda No. 338 Supplemental Budget No. 02 series of 2022 of the Municipality of Orani, Bataan, involving a total appropriation of ₱66,577,952.85 General Fund, ₱2,952,191.00 Economic Enterprise Market and Slaughterhouse and ₱754,840.00 Economic Enterprise Fishport for Additional Various Expenditures for the operation of the Municipal Government for Fiscal Year 2022 under Appropriation Ordinance No. 02, series of 2022.
- 3. Agenda No. 341 Supplemental Budget No. 02 FY 2022 of the Municipality of Samal, Bataan, involving a total appropriation of ₱3,842,227.32 under Appropriation Ordinance No. 22-002.
- 4. Agenda No. 348 Supplemental Budget No. 06- 2022 of the Municipality of Limay, Bataan, involving a total appropriation of P29,620,051.05 under Appropriation Ordinance No. 2022-007.

Under Section 327 of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan shall review the ordinance authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the same manner and within the same period prescribed for the review of other ordinances. The aforementioned appropriation ordinances complied with the requirements set forth by the Local Government Code and the Provincial Budget Officer did not interpose any objection to the same.

In addition, compliance with existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations shall be the sole responsibility of the Municipalities of Hermosa, Orani, Samal and Limay, Bataan, respectively.

5. Agenda No. 343 – Municipal Ordinance No. 22-004, passed by the Sangguniang Bayan of Samal, Bataan, entitled, "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING SPECIAL BENEFITS TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT WORKERS AND EMPLOYEES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAMAL, PROVINCE OF BATAAN, AND ALLOCATING FUNDS FOR "EXCENTENTIAL PROSESES ERVICE TOWARDS A BETTER QUALITY OF LIFE FOR ALL"



The Sagguniang Bayan of Samal, recognizes fully the contributions made by both the government and non-government personnel workers and employees to the local government of Samal, in the Province of Bataan. By granting special benefits to these workers, their efforts, cooperation and contribution in helping the local government would rather be properly recognized.

Agenda No,. 347 - Municipal Ordinance No. 11, series of 2022, passed by the Sangguniang Bayan of Orani, Bataan, entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL VICE-MAYOR TO MAKE AN AUGMENTATION OF APPROPRIATION FROM TRAVELLING **EXPENSES** (\$20,000.00)TRAINING **EXPENSES** (₱50,000.00) OFFICE SUPPLIES (₱50,000.00) LEGAL SERVICES (₱130,000.00) REPAIR & MAINTENANCE MACHINERY **MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT** (₱5,000.00) REPAIR & **EQUIPMENT** (₱5,000.00) AND **OTHER** TRANSPORTATION MAINTENANCE & OPERATING EXPENSES (₱25,000.00) TO OTHER SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS EXPENSES (₱85,000.00) MEMBERSHIP DUES & CONTRIBUTION TO ORGANIZATION (₱70,000.00) AND (₱130,000.00) OFFICE CONSULTANCY **SERVICES** MUNICIPAL VICE-MAYOR."

Under Section 336 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the local chief executive or the presiding officer of the Sanggunian concerned may, by ordinance, be authorized to augment any item in the approved annual budget for their respective offices from savings in other items within the same expense class of their respective appropriations.

We therefore request for the approval of resolutions declaring the validity of Agenda Nos. 337, 338, 341, 348, 343 and 347 respectively before this Body upon proper suspension of the rules.
