COMMITTEE REPORT COMMITTEE ON HEALTH

Formally referred to the SP Committee on Health was **Agenda No. 392** – Letter from Hon. Jose Enrique S. Garcia III, Provincial Governor of Bataan, RE: REQUEST FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE HEALTH PROMOTION FRAMEWORK STRATEGY (HPFS) 2030 IN THE PROVINCE-WIDE HEALTH SYSTEM OF BATAAN PURSUANT TO REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11223, OR THE UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE (UHC) ACT.

In accordance with Republic Act No. 11223 or the Universal Heathcare (UHC) Act, the Department of Health (DOH) formulated the Health Promotion Framework Strategy (HPFS) 2030 through DOH Order No. 2021-0063 to serve as the overall national health promotion roadmap and basis for all health promotion policies, programs and activities at the national, regional and local levels.

The HPFS requires the development and implementation of health promotion policies, programs and activities which shall focus on the following priority areas and risk factors: (i) diet and physical activity; (ii) environmental health; (iii) immunization; (iv) substance use; (v) mental health; (vi) sexual and reproductive health and (vii) violence and injury prevention.

The HPFS is a vital and strategic tool which can provide us guidance in operationalizing the comprehensive provisions of the UHC Act in the province and help us develop and implement the necessary health promotion policies, programs and activities.

After deliberation by this committee, as concluded in our committee meeting dated October 5, 2022, we find the request proper and an important tool for the healthcare of Bataeños. Therefore, we would like to request for the approval of Agenda **No. 392** subject to and without prejudice to the applicable laws, rules, regulations and policies upon suspension of the rules.
