Formally referred to the SP Committee on Health was **AGENDA NO. 298** — Letter from Hon. Jose Enrique S. Garcia III, Provincial Governor of Bataan, RE: REQUEST FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A RESOLUTION: (i) AUTHORIZING THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR TO REPRESENT JOSE C. PAYUMO, JR. MEMORIAL HOSPITAL (JCPJMH) IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ENDORSEMENT FUND PROGRAM OF THE PHILIPPINE CHARITY SWEEPSTAKES OFFICE (PCSO) AND TO SIGN DOCUMENTS / AGREEMENTS IN RELATION THERETO AND; (ii) DESIGNATING THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR AS THE AUTHORIZED PAYEE FOR THE ENDOWMENT FUND CHECK TO BE ISSUED BY PCSO.

The PCSO Endowment Fund Program provides funding support directly to government hospitals to augment their finances for the hospitalization and medical care of poor and disadvantaged patients. The additional funding from the PCSO will be beneficial to patients needing hospital care in Jose C. Payumo, Jr. Memorial Hospital (JCPJMH). It would also strengthen our medical assistance program and increase the accessibility of our health facilities. Moreover, the Endowment Fund will help JCPJMH cover the excess bills of patients not covered by PhilHealth under its No Balance Billing Policy.



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
